Landscaping Rocks are used to cover bare areas to mitigate erosion and enhance the appeal of the area. Colors, sizes, and textures are a few of the design elements that should be considered when selecting rocks.

### Do you have pets?

As pet owners ourselves we have your pet's best interest at heart when conducting a landscape project.

- Breeze is best used for pathways but can also cover areas where larger rocks are not desired such as pads or seating areas, can be used for dog areas but this tracks easily
- Pea gravel is quite friendly on the furry friends paws but keep in mind at 3/8" it will easily travel wherever those paws go.
- 3/4 sized rock compacts well and stays put, it's also a good option for the paws of your furry family
- 1.5" sized rock is best used for areas with lots of wind and needing lots of coverage that won't be used

### Not sure what color to go with?

- Trim colors and accent colors on your home's exterior allow opportunities to help tie the landscaping into the home
- Take a look around the property and take note of some of the colors you enjoy seeing this could provide a great opportunity to add more of it
- Reach out to your landscape estimator we will have plenty of guidance to help you through this process

### What sized rock should I choose?

- For areas that will be walked on we suggest using 3/4" or smaller
- Covering large areas, 1.5" adds some texture and depth to the area
- 2" and above is best used for erosion mitigation
- 4" and above is typically used on ditches or to cover hillsides
- 12" and above are categorized as boulders and are placed throughout the landscape for aesthetics
  - o For those who really love aesthetics check out our bubbling boulders!

### Will I need landscape fabric?

Landscape fabric is used to help block weed growth and to keep the rock from sinking into the ground. The key word in this phrase is help. Seeds will blow in, as well as dirt onto the fabric and once some water gets on it then you've got a weed in your newly landscaped area! Keep an eye out for these and simply pluck the weed once you see it come up. Make sure to ask about our Off Lawn Weed Control to help get in front of the problem before it becomes a problem.
